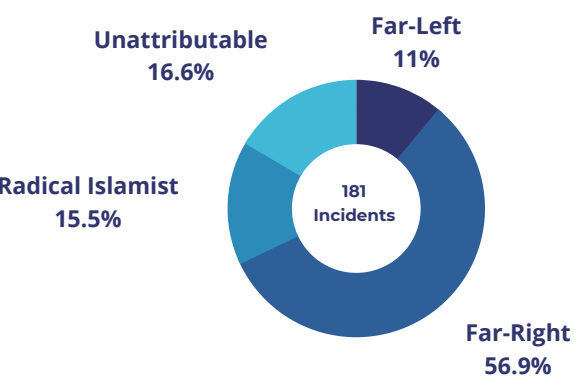

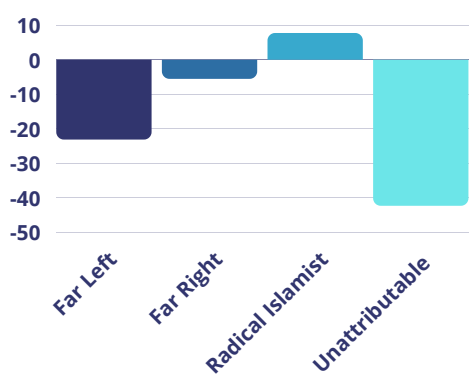

DECEMBER 2021 INCIDENT DATA - END OF YEAR SEES SPIKE IN ANTISEMITIC VANDALISM

As 2021 - a year marred by surging levels of Jew-hatred worldwide - drew to a close, the CAM Information Hub tracked **181 antisemitic incidents reported in the media in December**, a 15.0% overall decrease from November's 213 incidents. However, there was a 25.3% rise in incidents of vandalism in December, with a total of 94 -- 51.9% of all antisemitic incidents for the month.

There was also a 7.7% increase in incidents of radical Islamist antisemitism, while decreases of 5.5%, 23.1%, and 42.3% were recorded in the far-right, far-left, and unattributable categories. In total for 2021, **CAM monitored 2,214 media reports of antisemitic incidents** worldwide.

Supporters of Neo-Nazi Group Leave Antisemitic Leaflets Outside Homes in at Least Nine U.S. States

The Goyim Defense League (GDL), a neo-Nazi organization, was responsible for the mass distribution of leaflets propagating conspiracy theories blaming Jews for the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, among other baseless and inflammatory claims. The same group was behind a number of similar provocative stunts this past year in cities across America.



Zahra Billoo's Hateful Speech Reinforces CAIR's Antisemitism Problems

In a vociferously antisemitic address delivered at an American Muslims for Palestine (AMP) convention, Zahra Billoo - a Muslim civil rights lawyer who serves as the executive director of the San Francisco Bay Area office of the Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR) - used bigoted and threatening rhetoric that typified contemporary Islamist Jew-hatred. Instead of condemning Billoo, CAIR made allegations of an organized smear campaign against her, showing antisemitism remains a core part of the organization's DNA.
