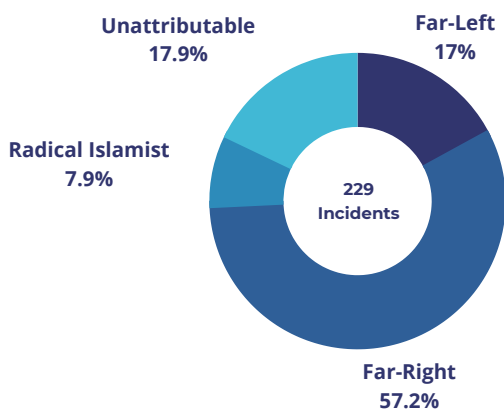


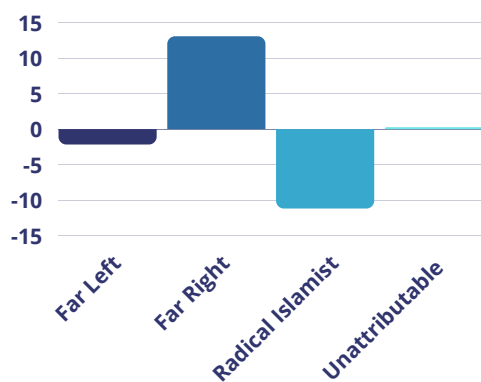

FEBRUARY 2022 INCIDENT DATA - NEARLY 45% INCREASE IN MONITORED ANTISEMITIC ACTIVITY

In total, the CAM Information Hub tracked **229 antisemitic incidents reported in the media in February**, a 44.9% increase from the prior month, and a 40.5% increase from the same month last year.

February 2022 experienced a 52.3% increase in incidents of far-right antisemitism, and a 21.9% increase in incidents of far-left antisemitism, compared to February 2021, while a decrease of 21.7% was seen in the Islamist category.

CAM monitored 16 physical threats targeting Jews, a 166.7% rise for the month of February year-over-year. 93 incidents of antisemitic vandalism were monitored, a 116.3% increase year-over-year.

Spike in Coordinated Social Media Activity Calling for Release of 'Lady Al Qaeda' Preceded Texas Synagogue Attack, New Study Reveals

A sudden spike in coordinated [social media](#) activity calling for the release of convicted "Lady Al Qaeda" terrorist Aafia Siddiqui preceded the Jan. 15th hostage-taking incident at Congregation Beth Israel in Colleyville, Texas, in which British Islamist extremist Malik Faisal Akram demanded the U.S. free her from prison, [new research](#) released by CAM and conducted by the Network Contagion Research Institute (NCRI) shows.



CAM Information Hub Database of IHRA Antisemitism Definition Adoptions by US States

A growing number of U.S. states have adopted or endorsed the IHRA Working Definition of Antisemitism. A total of **19 U.S. states** have done so thus far, according to data compiled by the CAM Information Hub. One of the most effective steps a state can take — via legislation, resolutions, executive orders, and/or executive proclamations — to fight Jew-hatred is to adopt the IHRA Working Definition of Antisemitism.
