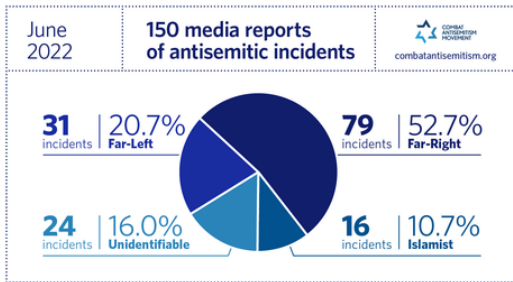
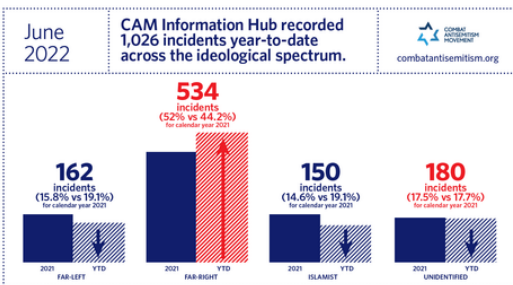

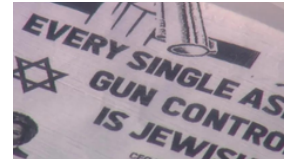
JUNE 2022 INCIDENTS DATA - 6.4% YEAR-TO-DATE DECREASE FROM 2021

The CAM Information Hub tracked **150 antisemitic incidents reported in the media worldwide in June 2022**, marking a daily average of 5.0 incidents. Year-to-date, CAM has recorded a total of 1,026 incidents, or an average of 5.7 incidents per day, down 6.4% from the same time frame in 2021.

June 2022 saw 79 incidents of far-right antisemitism (52.7% of total), as well as 31 (20.7%), 16 (10.7%), and 24 (16.0%) in the far-left, Islamist, and unidentifiable categories, respectively.

CAM also monitored 19 physical threats against Jews in June, as well as 68 incidents of antisemitic vandalism.

Ten Most Shocking Antisemitic Incidents of June 2022

The ten most shocking antisemitic incidents of June 2022 included the publication by a pro-BDS Boston-area activist collective of an interactive map featuring names and addresses of local Jewish institutions.

The map was widely condemned by Jewish groups and U.S. lawmakers for propagating antisemitic tropes and potentially inciting violence, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) said it was "very well aware and are tracking" the "Mapping Project" website.

Database Details Growing Normalization of Holocaust Trivialization in Past Year

Between July 2021 and July 2022, the CAM Information Hub monitored 212 incidents of Holocaust trivialization, or the purposeful obfuscation of the distinctive nature and scope of the Nazi genocide of the Jews, worldwide.

Fueled by rancorous debates over Covid-19 health measures, manifestations of this trend became all-too-common in the public sphere, crisscrossing the ideological and political spectrum.

Antisemitic Flyers Distributed Across 11 US States in June, CAM Data Shows

A total of 26 incidents of antisemitic flyers across 11 U.S. states -- including California, Florida, Illinois, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas, Virginia, and Wisconsin -- were reported in June, marking the continuation of a troubling pattern that has plagued the country recently.

In a majority of the occurrences, the apparent perpetrators were supporters of the neo-Nazi Goyim Defense League (GDL).
