Keyword "Jew" Window 2 Aug 3:34 PM – 3 Aug 3:34 AM ET (12 hrs) Sample 963 posts

DEFINITION OF HOSTILITY

A post is classified as hostile when it presents Jews in a negative light or otherwise speaks about them in an antisemitic way. This includes slurs, conspiracy tropes, dehumanizing language, and calls for harm.

Key Findings

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Hostile content dominated the sample.

Of 963 posts analyzed in a 12-hour window, 692 (71.9%) were classified as hostile toward Jews. Only 245 (25.4%) were neutral and 26 (2.7%) were positive. The discourse environment around this keyword is overwhelmingly negative and antisemitic.

Violent and genocidal language at the top of the range.

Multiple posts included explicit calls for harm, statements that Jews should be dead, and rhetoric framing Jewish people as a "bioweapon" deployed against white people.

Hostility came from multiple ideological directions.

Some posts used white-nationalist frameworks, including race science claims and neo-Nazi numerical signaling. Others used pro-Palestinian framing to generalize hostility toward Jewish people as a whole. Recurring tropes included media and political control, dual loyalty, and Freemasonry as a feeder network for Jewish power.

Examples

Content warning. Posts are reproduced verbatim, including slurs, sexual violence and incitement, for evidentiary and escalation purposes.

SEVERE

“Little Jew boys running around in America like they’re tough. Weak little cunts.”

Highest-reach post in the sample. Combines ethnic slurring with violent language.

TROPE

“This is the Jew that pushed this bullshit into the mainstream... Jews will simultaneously use archeology to smear Indo European history while being polish and claiming they have a direct line from Moses.”

Dual-loyalty and historical revisionism tropes used to discredit Jewish heritage claims.

INCITEMENT

“He is a little jew fuck that was rage baiting people in their own house. He should be dead.”

Explicit incitement to lethal violence against a named individual.

TROPE

“You’re admitting you’re a Jew bioweapon?”

The “Jewish bioweapon” conspiracy trope used as a casual dismissal in political argument.

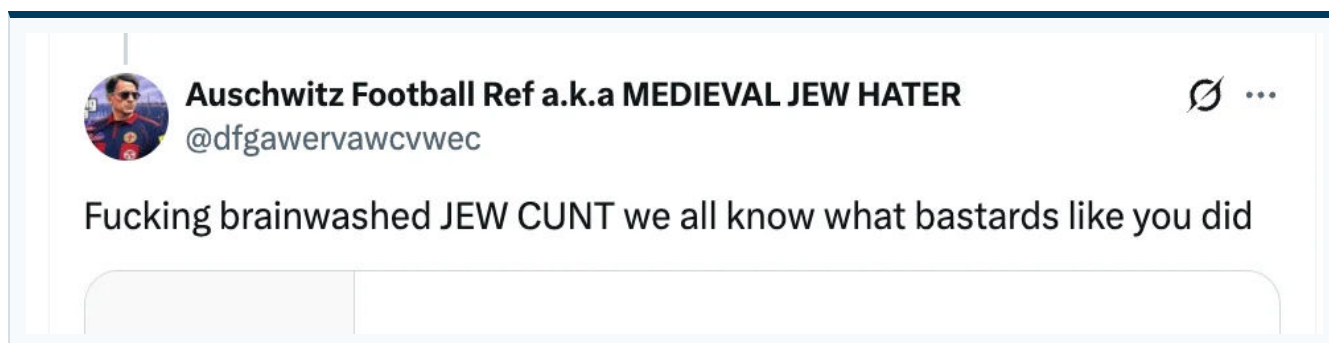


Figure 1 — Caption for the supporting visual.

@FuhrerRysing [View post](#)

SEVERE

“She’s a fucking Jew using her fucking brown bioweapons to try to genocide white people.”

Invokes the white-genocide conspiracy theory and wishes sexual violence on the subject.

SEVERE · 1488

“Jake is a fucking crypto jew. He’s not a white man. These shitskins will know it when the whites have had enough.”

Race theory paired with a veiled threat of violence. The handle contains 1488, a known neo-Nazi code.

Methodology

Keyword scan of the term “Jew” on X, covering 12 hours, with a minimum engagement threshold of zero likes so that low-visibility posts were captured. The dataset is not exhaustive. Each post was classified by a model trained to detect antisemitic sentiment, producing a category and a hostility score. CAM staff review a sample of the classifications to verify accuracy and contextual coherence. Examples are drawn from the 40 highest-reach posts, ordered by reach.

Recommendations

01 X should act on the highest-severity posts in this sample.

The most extreme posts contain incitement to violence, genocidal rhetoric, and neo-Nazi signaling, in clear breach of X’s own violent speech and hateful conduct policies. X Trust and Safety should remove this content, enforce against the accounts behind it, and report back on the action taken.

02 X should monitor this keyword continuously, not reactively.

A hostility rate of 71.9% on a single term indicates a systemic problem rather than isolated violations. X should place this keyword under standing review, measure the rate over time, and treat sustained levels of this kind as a trigger for proactive enforcement.
